The 3 remaining bedrooms are all double in size and have built in robes and ceiling fans with bed 4 offering access to the front verandah too.

The large kitchen is generous in size with stainless steel appliances including fridge, dishwasher and gas cooking plus a large walk-in pantry, plenty of bench space and breakfast bar. The front verandah runs the length of the house whilst the back deck offers a relaxing outdoor space off the family room and overlooks the backyard.
